In Case of Ties:

Case-I: For Honours Courses:

- If and only if, the Index of Merit is same, then the Subject Marks in HS (or 10+2 Equivalent) Examination will be considered for ranking.
- If the Index of Merit and the Subject Marks both are same, then the Aggregate Percentage Marks (rounded up to two decimal points) of Madhyamik (or 10th Standard) Examination will be considered for ranking.

Case-II: For General Courses:

- If the Index of Merit is same then the Aggregate Percentage Marks (rounded up to two decimal points) of Madhyamik (or 10th Standard) Examination will be considered for ranking.
